

CURRICULUM VITAE

Luigi Giuseppe Bongiovanni is a clinical neurologist at the Section of Neurology B , Department of Neurological , Biomedical and Movement Sciences, University of Verona, Italy. In 1988 and in 1993, he was a Research Fellow at the Department of Clinical Neurophysiology of the University of Uppsala, under the direction of K.E. Hagbarth. During this period of time he was involved in microneurographic recordings of peripheral nerve activity and, with Dr. M. Nordin, in scientific projects related to fatigue effects on recruitment and firing of different motor units. He was also involved in evaluation of the various components of sympathetic and parasympathetic nervous activity, in order to quantify the degree and the extension of the autonomic dysfunctions mainly in degenerative pathology. In this field he has been a speaker for a long time at the annual Course in Electromyography and Clinical Neurophysiology organized by the University of Ferrara in collaboration with other Italian and Foreign Universities , and at the Course in EEG and Related Techniques organized by the University of Pisa. He has also worked at the local Epilepsy Center for a long time. His teaching and training experience is composed by lectures to medical students, lab tutorial and teaching in EEG and autonomic dysfunctions for students in Medicine, graduate students and for residents in Neurology. From 1993 to 1999 he was a member of the Board of the Italian Society of Clinical Neurophysiology (SINC). From 1999 to 2010 he was appointed as a coordinator of the Study Group in Vegetative Nervous System of the same society.
